

Resources for Non-Spay/Neuter Veterinary Care

The Pet Fund

This fund will send the money to the vet or clinic directly if approved. This is for NON emergency vet care only. The application needs to be sent with an email to info@thepetfund.com including your email, name, and reachable phone number to be considered.

The Pet Fund works only on non-basic, non-urgent care. This category includes medical needs such as cancer treatment, heart disease, chronic conditions, endocrine diseases, eye diseases, etc. <https://thepetfund.org> Urgent Care Grants- Red Rover Relief This program provides financial assistance to pet owners struggling with expenses for a pet with life-threatening situations only. Average grant awarded is \$250. In order to qualify the household income of the owner MUST be less than \$60,000.
